## **Holding of the Second Meeting of the Review Committee for the Earthquake and Tsunami Evacuation and Swift Disaster Recovery Plans at Airports**

### **1. Outline**

In order to implement the safe and orderly evacuation procedures and resume normal operations as soon as possible at the airports in the event of an earthquake and a tsunami across a wide area, based on the summary report on the Best Form of Disaster Preparedness at Airport Facilities in Anticipation of Widespread Disaster, including the Nankai Trough Megathrust Earthquake submitted by the Committee in March of this year, Civil Aviation Bureau of Japan (JCAB) plans to develop a “standard model” of emergency evacuation and swift disaster recovery plans using Kochi Airport, and then urges all airports across the country to develop its own plans.

For this purpose, JCAB has established the Review Committee for the Earthquake and Tsunami Evacuation and Swift Disaster Recovery Plans at Airports, headed by Professor Tomoyuki Todoroki of Nihon University, and held the first meeting on October 7, 2015.

This is to inform you that JCAB will hold the meeting for the second time and for the last time as described below, and the final reports will be posted on the MLIT’s official website at a later date.
