■Background of the Workshop and future initiatives

The Davao City Bypass Construction Project is a bypass road project (including a 2.3km tunnel) that connects the southern end of Davao City with the city center. This is the first full-scale road tunnel ("Davao tunnel") in the Philippines, and the project (Special Terms for Economic Partnership project) is expected to utilize Japanese technologies. It was awarded to a JV of Shimizu Corporation, Takenaka Civil Engineering & Construction, and a Philippine company in April 2020.

In October 2022, MLIT and DPWH signed a Memorandum of Cooperation (MOC), confirming cooperation in sharing road tunnel technology and continuing business matching workshops, holding regular opinion exchange meetings and supporting the business activities of Japanese expressway companies.

Based on the MOU, a business workshop was recently held, as in the previous fiscal year, wherein Japanese expressway companies and Philippine companies promoted business cooperation and did regular sharing of road tunnel technology.
